

Stories on the Skin: Tattoo Culture at FAU

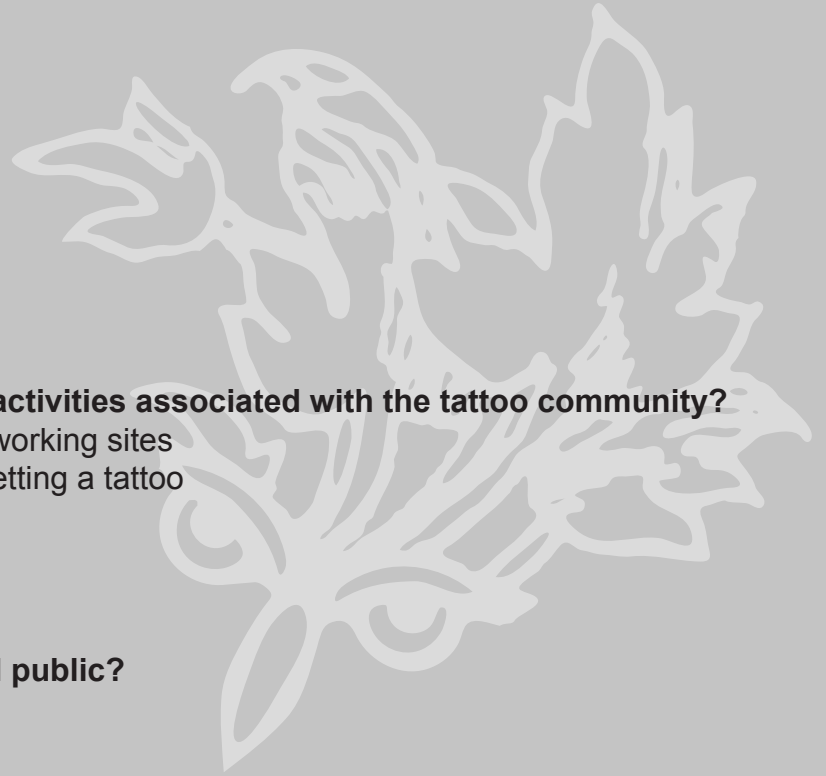
