**Norman J.W. Goda** is the Braman Professor of Holocaust Studies at the University of Florida. He is co-author, with Richard Breitman, of *U.S. Intelligence and the Nazis* (2005) and *Hitler's Shadow: Allied Counterintelligence, Nazi Criminals, and the Cold War* (2010), and was also a U.S. government consultant on the implementation of the Nazi War Crimes Disclosure Act of 1998.
