## **Henderson Fourth Grade Students Print and Bind Books at FAU Libraries' Arthur and Mata Jaffe Center**

**BOCA RATON, FL (May 11, 2009)** – Twenty-two fourth grade students from Florida Atlantic University's A.D. Henderson University School will visit the Arthur and Mata Jaffe Center for Book Arts at the Wimberly Library on FAU's Boca Raton campus on Wednesday, May 13, from 9 to 11 a.m.

The students from Henderson, which is a public school district functioning as a learning laboratory on FAU's campus, will be divided into two groups during their visit. Each group will spend 50 minutes in the Jaffe center viewing books with Collections Specialist Seth Thompson and 50 minutes printing and binding books with Programs Coordinator John Cutrone. Students will be allowed to keep books they create.

The Jaffe center is a 4,800-square-foot center that houses one of the nation's most prominent collections of books handmade by artists. The center establishes FAU as a major national contributor to book arts education.
